Suspensions (4 bills):

- 1) **H.Con.Res. 322** – Expressing the Sense of Congress regarding the contribution of the USO to the morale and welfare of our servicemen and women of our armed forces and their families (*Rep. Miller {FL} – Armed Services*)
- 2) **H.Res. 629** – Supporting the goals and ideals of a Day of Hearts, Congenital Heart Defect Day in order to increase awareness about congenital heart defects, and for other purposes (*Rep. Price {GA} – Government Reform*)
- 3) **H.R. 4152** – Raymond J. Salmon Post Office Designation Act (*Rep. McGovern – Government Reform*)
- 4) **S. 1989** – Holly A. Charette Post Office Designation Act (*Sen. Reed – Government Reform*)

TOMORROW'S OUTLOOK

The GOP Leadership has announced the following schedule: on Wednesday, the House will meet at 10:00 a.m. for legislative business. The House is expected to consider three bills under Suspension of the Rules including **S.Con.Res. 79** - A concurrent resolution expressing the sense of Congress that no United States assistance should be provided directly to the Palestinian Authority if any representative political party holding a majority of parliamentary seats within the Palestinian Authority maintains a position calling for the destruction of Israel (*Sen. Thune - International Relations*).
