- 1) **H.Con.Res. 260** - Recognizing the 40th anniversary of the Second Vatican Council's Declaration on the Relation of the Church to Non-Christian Religions, *Nostra Aetate*, and the continuing need for mutual interreligious respect and dialogue (*Rep. Holt - International Relations*)
- 2) **H.R. 1973** - Water for the Poor Act of 2005 (*Rep. Blumenauer - International Relations*)
- 3) **H.Con.Res. 273** - Recognizing the 50th anniversary of the Montgomery bus boycott (*Rep. Rogers {AL} - Government Reform*)
- 4) **H.Res. 444** - Gynecological Resolution for Advancement of Ovarian Cancer Education (*Rep. Hall - Energy and Commerce*)

TOMORROW'S OUTLOOK

The GOP Leadership has announced the following schedule: on Tuesday, the House will meet at 10:00 a.m. for legislative business and is expected to consider seven bills under Suspension of the Rules. The House may also go to conference and instruct conferees on: **HR2863** – Department of Defense Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2006 (*Young {FL} – Appropriations*); **HR3058** – Transportation, Treasury, HUD, Judiciary, District of Columbia Appropriations Act 2006 (*Knollenberg – Appropriations*); or **HR3010** – Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2006 (*Regula – Appropriations*).
