The House will meet at 12:30 p.m. for morning hour and at 2:00 p.m. for legislative business. **Votes are postponed until 6:30 p.m.**

Suspensions (3 bills):

The House is scheduled to consider 3 Suspension bills. Suspension bills are debatable for 40 minutes each, may not be amended, and require two-thirds majority for passage.

- 1) H.Res.106-** Congratulating Lutheran schools, students, parents, teachers, administrators, and congregations across the Nation for their ongoing contributions to education, and for other purposes (Bereuter- Ed and Wkforce)
- 2) H.Con.Res. 54-** Honoring Visiting Nurses Association (Markey- Gov't Reform)
- 3) H.Res. 111-** Honoring the legacy of Fred Rogers and his dedication to creating a more compassionate, kind, and loving world for children and adults (Doyle- Gov't Reform)
