FLOOR SCHEDULE

Suspensions (11 bills):

- 1) **H.R. 23** - To amend the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 to authorize communities to use community development block grant funds for construction of tornado-safe shelters in manufactured home parks (Rep. Bachus - Financial Services)
- 2) **S. 1280** - A bill to amend the Protect Act to clarify certain volunteer liability (Sen. Hatch / Rep. Sensenbrenner - Judiciary)
- 3) **H.R. 1437** - To improve the United States Code (Rep. Sensenbrenner - Judiciary)
- 4) **H.R. 2249** - To amend chapter 10 of title 39, United States Code, to include postmasters and postmasters' organizations in the process for the development and planning of certain personnel policies, schedules, and programs of the United States Postal Service (Rep. McHugh - Government Reform)
- 5) **H.Res. 240** - Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that there should be established a National Community Health Center Week to raise awareness of health services provided by community, migrant, public housing, and homeless health centers (Rep. Davis {IL} - Government Reform)
- 6) **H.Con.Res. 230** - Honoring the 10 communities selected to receive the 2003 All-America City Award (Rep. Hayes - Government Reform)
- 7) **S. 1399** - A bill to redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 101 South Vine Street in Glenwood, Iowa, as the "William J. Scherle Post Office Building" (Sen. Harkin / Sen. Grassley - Government Reform)
- 8) **H.R. 2328** - To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 2001 East Willard Street in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, as the "Robert A. Borski Post Office Building" (Rep. Hoeffel - Government Reform)
- 9) **H.Con.Res. 212** - Recognizing and supporting the goals and ideals of the Year of the Korean War Veteran (Rep. S. Johnson - Veterans' Affairs)
- 10) **H.R. 2357** - To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish standards of access to care for veterans seeking health care from the Department of Veterans Affairs (Rep. Brown-Waite - Veterans' Affairs)
- 11) **H.R. 1516** - To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a national cemetery for veterans in southeastern Pennsylvania (Rep. Gerlach - Veterans' Affairs)

Postponed Vote on Van Hollen Motion to Instruct Conferees on the Child Tax Credit. The motion instructs conferees to insist on the Senate-passed Child Tax Credit Measure and is identical to the one that passed in the House on June 12th, 205-201. It also instructs Conferees to report out a conference report no later than the second legislative day after adoption of this motion.
